ATTENTION: CAPE COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT:

On May 14, 2019, the Sewer District Board of Directors discussed and approved the budget for the 2020 fiscal year. Effective July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020: service availability fee will remain \$30, usage rate is increasing to \$4.50 per 1000 gal. (previously \$3.50 per 1000 gal).

Please remember that the Sewer District is a non-profit utility. The rate increase is due to increased operational costs of our systems and to provide a "government mandated" reserve in the event of unforeseen repairs, breakdowns, or expenses.

Fee & Rate Summary: Service availability fee; \$30 charged to all customers with an active water meter. Commercial usage: \$4.50 per 1000 gallons of pervious months water usage. Residential usage: \$4.50 per 1000 gallons usage based on December 2018, January 2019 & February 2019 average. New residential customers with no usage history will be charged \$45 a month (including the \$30 fee). Payments are due on the 16th of each month (or next business day if weekend or holiday), failure to receive bill does not relieve customer of this obligation. Any payment received after the due date will have an addition 10% late fee added. Accounts with a pass due balance in excess of \$100 are subject to water disconnection without further notice and will be charge \$50 fee once the water district is dispatched.
